Difficulty:	Level 2 – Students should be aware of and have worked on
	projects using techniques listed in level 1 description.
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Class Requirements:

- Blue Onion Quilt Pattern by "Saginaw St Quilts", Retail \$9.00
- "Ovals Always" Ruler by Creative Grids, Retail \$49.99.

Class Supplies:

- Sewing machine in good working order. Please bring whatever foot allows you to sew an accurate 1/4" seam. Don't forget the power cord and foot pedal! It can also be helpful to bring along the User Manual.
- Rotary cutter, mat and large ruler.
- 10 1/2" (or larger) square ruler
- Basic sewing supplies (e. Scissors, pins, seam ripper)
- If you have one, a design wall would be very helpful. A flannel-backed table cloth works very good for this purpose, and can be purchased very inexpensively at dollar stores.

Fabric Requirements:

- 3/8 yard each of 12 different contrasting prints. I found it helpful to choose 3 colors that I liked together, then pick 4 fabrics in each color. The pattern recommends 4 colors. It is a good idea to have a variety of lights, mediums and darks. Choose fabrics that you love.
- Extra fabric needed for backing and binding. I suggest you wait to purchase this until you decide whether or not to add borders.
