<p>This Two-Block Focus Class is a fun, hands-on journey that celebrates America's 250th birthday by exploring two traditional Ohio blocks: the pieced Ohio Star and the appliquéd Ohio Rose. In this class you'll learn to sew the quarter-square triangles that form the Ohio Star and to create the Rose with freezer-paper templates. You'll learn to do invisible turned-edge applique by machine, but also have the option to do the applique by hand.</p> <p>Open to confident beginners as well as more experienced quilters seeking to expand their repertoire, you'll leave with two finished blocks that honor Ohio's quilting heritage while marking the broader American tradition celebrated in this milestone year.</p>

Class Requirements:

- Pattern: \$12.00 payable to teacher at start of class.

Class Supplies:

- Sewing Machine in good working order with manual, foot pedal and any additional accoutrements.
- A light box, if you have one. Instructor will bring one to share.
- 1/4" foot (#37 for a Bernina)
- A foot with an opening in front for easy viewing (#20 or 20C for a Bernina)
- Bobbins with neutrall gray 60 wt. bobbin thread
- "Invisible" nylon or polyester thread in clear and/or smoke
- Thread(s) to match your fabrics
- Size 11 and 12 Universal Machine Needles
- A piece of Freezer paper, about 18" square.
- Inexpensive water-soluble glue stick
- Straight pins
- Scissors – small, sharp, for fabric (5" – 8" would work)
- Seam Ripper (just in case)
- Pencil – regular lead
- Rotary cutter and mat, and a 24" ruler
- Small Iron and wooden based ironing surface, if you have one. The instructor will bring an iron to share.

Fabric Requirements:

- Ohio Star: scraps or fat quarters:
 - 1 color for the star
 - 1 color for the background
- Ohio Rose: Scraps or fat quarters:
 - 2 colors for the rose & buds
 - 1 color for the leaves
 - 1 color for the center
 - A square at least 18" X 18" (or a fat quarter) for the background
- Later, to finish: you might want fabric for borders, backing, batting, and binding.
