


## Class 102 Peace by Piece, A Nativity Workshop Supply List

Class Length:	2 days, Monday and Tuesday
Difficulty Level:	Level 2 - Students should be aware of and have worked on projects using a sewing machine, iron, and rotary tools and have an understanding of proper thread tension, stitch size, and seam allowance consistency.
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<p style="text-align: center;">Starry Night, Noel or Oh Little Town--You choose!</p> <p>Each of these three patterns makes an adorable nativity quilt, perfect for adding a meaningful touch to your holiday decor. You will learn how to sew curves easily by using the Wonder Curve Ruler by Sew Kind of Wonderful. No pins, finding centers, or using glue are necessary for making these curves and you will end up with smooth curves with no pleats or puckers.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Starry Night 75" x 78" / Noel 54" x 57" / Oh Little Town 42" x 42"</p>	

### Class Requirements:

- Sew Kind of Wonderful (SKoW) Wonder Curve Ruler, retail \$32.
- Your choice of pattern from Sew Kind of Wonderful for your party:
  - SKoW Starry Night Pattern, retail \$26
  - SKoW Starry Night Cow Bonus Pattern (optional), retail \$12.
  - SKoW Noel Pattern, retail \$26
  - SKoW Oh Little Town Pattern, retail \$30.
- SKoW Sew Square (optional but highly recommended)
  - 4" ruler, retail \$13.
  - 3" ruler, retail \$9.

Class Supplies:

- Sewing machine, power cord, instruction manual and foot pedal
- ¼" foot
- Neutral color thread
- Seam ripper (just in case)
- scissors/snips
- Cutting mat
- ruler
- 45mm rotary cutter (Quilters Select and the Martelli ones do not work well in cutting the curves, but are fine to use when squaring the blocks).
- Iron and ironing pad (wool mats must be used with another sewing pad). There will be a couple ironing stations in the classroom, but you may want one at your work station.

Fabric Requirements:

\*\*\* I will have fat quarters available for sale from Somewhere Sewing (Millersburg, Ohio) if you change your mind from what you bring along. Precutting instructions will be e-mailed by September 1st.

- Starry Night Fabric Requirements
  - ½ yard—faces
  - 3 fat eighths for hair and beard
  - 23 assorted fat eighths for clothes, blanket, crook, wings
  - 1 fat eighth for star
  - 1 fat eighth for manger
  - 1 fat eighth for stable
  - 1 fat quarter for donkey body
  - 2 fat eighths for donkey accents
  - 3 fat quarters assorted greens for palm fronds
  - 1 fat quarter for tree trunks
  - 1 fat quarter for sheep body
  - 1 fat eighth for sheep face/accent
  - 5 fat eighths assorted for buildings
  - 4 10x10 squares for building accents
  - 1 fat eighth for building #3 accent
  - ½ yard for camel fabric
  - 2 fat eighths camel accents
  - 3 fat quarters for camel blanket
  - ½ yard main cow fabric (optional for cow)
  - ¼ yard cow head/accent (optional for cow)
  - 1 fat eighth cow horn (optional for cow)
  - 1 fat eighth cow muzzle/ear (optional for cow)
  - 5 ½ yards background
  - 5 yards backing (not needed at camp)

- 2/3 yards binding (not needed at camp)

- Noel Fabric Requirements
  - 3—6" WOF (width of fabric) assorted face fabrics (almond, gray, Sienna)
  - 10—1/4 yard assorted fabrics for the people (blues, teal, citrine, green, dark green, pink, red, lilac, maroon, dark purple)
  - 1—1/3 yard fabric for people (black for beards and hair)
  - 2—1/2 yard cuts for people (yellow and brown—can use scraps totaling this amount)
  - Background fabrics:
    - 2—1/2 yard cuts assorted background fabrics (taupe for Bethlehem blocks, & the Holy family, pale green for the palm tree and shepherd)
    - 2—2/3 yard assorted background fabrics (tan for sheep/donkey & light gray for angel/wiseman)
    - 1—3/4 yard cream for the other palm tree and camel
    - **OR** 3 1/4 yards of one background fabric
  - 3 yards backing (not needed at camp)
  - 1/2 yard binding (not needed at camp)
- Oh Little Town Fabric Requirements
  - 29—4" WOF (width of fabric) assorted focus fabrics
  - 5—6" WOF assorted focus fabrics (3 for palm fronds, 1 for sheep body, 1 for donkey body)
  - 1—9" WOF for the cow body
  - 2 1/2 yards background fabric
  - 2 2/3 yards backing (not needed at camp)
  - 1/3 yard binding (not needed at camp)
