Description:	<p>Create some stars and tuck them in a Log Cabin. Triangles on the corners combine with cornerstones to create a secondary design running diagonally on your quilt. This quilt uses just three colors. How about red, white, and blue for a patriotic quilt, or blues and purples for a serene, soothing quilt, or go bright for the summer.</p> <p>This project uses 3 Creative Grids rulers to aid in speed and accuracy in piecing - Ultimate Flying Goose Tool, Log Cabin (8 inch) Trim Tool and Folded Corner Clipper XL Tool.</p>

**Class Requirements:**

- Pattern - Stars in the Cabin, Cut Loose Press \$3.99. Please contact me if your local quilt shop doesn't carry this pattern.
- Ult. Flying Goose, CGRDH4, \$27.99
- Log Cabin Trim Tool, CGRJAW1, \$25.99
- Folded Corner Clipper XL, CGRFCCXL, \$26.49 (optional)

**Class Supplies:**

- Sewing machine, with ¼" foot, power cord and foot pedal
- Small cutting mat
- Rotary cutter (45mm or 60mm is fine), extra blades
- Seam ripper (sigh...)
- Thread, neutral or color to match fabric
- Iron and pressing mat
- Basic sewing supplies – pins, small scissors, etc.
- Marking tool (frixion pen, mechanical pencil, pigma pen)

Fabric Requirements:

For 56" x 84" quilt, you will need:

- Stars, triangle and cornerstones – 2 ½ yards
- Star backgrounds – 1 ¼ yards
- Log cabin strips – ¾ yards of 8 prints or 5 ½ yards if using one print
- Binding – 5/8 yard (not needed at camp)

If you wish to make a different size, contact me.

Pre-class cutting instructions:

- Cut fabrics as specified in the pattern. Please mark each size patch as some are similar in size.
- Bring all extra fabrics to class.
