All supplies/tools will be provided to paint your Barn Quilt. Brushes, paint, fan, tape, and tools will be provided in class for you to use. You will be painting on Aluminum Sign Boards which are much easier to hang than wood and will not deteriorate. 160 paint colors to choose from. Once you pick your design and project, your board will be primed and ready to paint in class. In class, you will learn how to sand, prime, draw a design and paint a Barn Quilt. Hanging instructions will also be provided in class.

Class Requirements: You have these options –

- \$125 for one 24x24 barn quilt block
- \$225 for one 36x36 barn quilt block
- \$125 for 4 Ladder Blocks, 12 x 12 each
- info on ladder purchase will be provided in class

Class Supplies:

Wear an old shirt or bring an apron. This is not messy but you may get paint on your shirt from leaning over your board. Go home with a completed project!
