Class Requirements:

- Jelly Weave Quilt Pattern by “Cluck Cluck Sew, LLC”, Retail \$9.49

Class Supplies:

- Sewing machine in good working order. Don't forget the power cord and foot pedal! It can also be helpful to bring along the User Manual.
- Please bring whatever foot allows you to sew an accurate 1/4" seam.
- Rotary cutter, mat and large ruler.
- Basic sewing supplies (e. Scissors, pins, seam ripper)
- Choose a thread color that blends well with the colors of your fabrics. I like to use a light gray as it seems to blend with everything

Fabric Requirements:

- 40 pre-cut 2 1/2" strips (jelly roll) or 14 assorted 1/4 yards for lap size quilt. If you are starting with yardage, please cut 3 strips - 2 1/2" x WOF (width of fabric) from each quarter yard. (This should be done prior to class)
- Background fabric – 3 yards (Make sure there is a lot of contrast between your strips and the background fabric. The background should be something that enhances/highlights your strip fabrics)
- Extra fabric needed for backing and binding. This will not be needed for the class. Please see the pattern or contact me for quantities.

Pre-cutting is not required for this class.
