Description:	Capture the Fourth of July in a quilt. Use Creative Grids Kitty Cornered ruler to make the fireworks easily and accurately, then surround them with Flying Geese to evoke fireworks in the sky. The blocks are large, so just 20 will make a generous twin size quilt.

Class Requirements:

- Creative Grids Kitty Cornered ruler \$29.49
- Cut Loose Press Liberty Runner pattern (\$3.99) Contact me if your local quilt shop doesn't carry this pattern.

Class Supplies

- Sewing machine, with 1/4" foot, power cord and foot pedal
- Small cutting mat
- Rotary cutter (45mm or 60mm is fine), extra blades
- Seam ripper (sigh...)
- Thread, neutral or color to match fabric
- Iron and pressing mat
- Basic sewing supplies pins, small scissors, etc.
- Marking tool (frixion pen, mechanical pencil, pigma pen)

Fabric Requirements:

- Background 2 ½ yards
- Red Stars and sashing—2 1/3 yards
- Dark Blue star points 1 1/8 yards
- Light Blue star points 3/4 yard
- Outer Border 1 yard
- Binding 5/8 yard (not needed at camp)

Pre-class cutting instructions:

- This quilt is adapted from a table runner, so the cutting requirements are different than those listed on the pattern. In addition, some of the pieces listed in the pattern are over-generous.
- I suggest you label each size piece as you cut them.

Background

```
5 strips 4 ½" x WOF, subcut (40) 4 ½" squares 6 strips 4 ¼" x WOF, subcut (80) 4 ¼" x 3" rectangles 7 strips 3 ½" x WOF, subcut (80) 3 ½" squares
```

Red Stars

8 strips 4" x WOF, subcut (80) 4" squares
3 strips 12 ½" x WOF, subcut (48) 2 ½" x 12 ½" strips for sashing
***1 strip 2 ½" x WOF, sub cut (1) 2 ½" x 12 ½" strip for sashing
***wait to cut this strip, you may get enough 2 ½" x 12" strips from the previous step.

Dark Blue

```
8 strips 4" x WOF, subcut (80) 4" squares 2 strips 2 ½ x WOF, subcut (30) 2 ½" squares
```

Light Blue

5 strips 4 ½" x WOF, subcut (40) 4 ½" squares

Outer Border (need not be brought to camp) 9 strips 3 ½" x WOF
