Description:	<p>Even though kaleidoscope quilts can be quick to make up, they can provide a great opportunity to get creative. Quilts can be made as scrappy or as planned as you like. We will learn about contrast to make your quilt pop. Here are some examples - https://pin.it/6gDjV76</p> <p>This isn't intended to be a "stack and whack" class but I will show techniques to make interesting blocks from striped or interesting prints.</p> <p>Teaching points:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Using contrast to enhance your quilt design • Cutting and Pressing tips • Perfecting that ¼" seam allowance • Chain Piecing

Class Requirements:

- Kaleido-Ruler, small (Marti Mitchell) Retail \$15-\$20 **OR** Kaleidoscope Ruler (Creative Grids) Retail \$ 24.
- NOTE: If you use the large Marti Mitchell ruler you will need wider strips
- Students can order small Marti Mitchell rulers from me, probably less than \$10.

Class Supplies:

- Sewing Machine in good working order, with instruction book
- Basic Sewing Supplies (thread, needles, pins, snips, scissors, bobbins)
- Rotary Cutter and Mat
- Ruler – You won't need anything larger than 12 ½" long if you do some precutting before you come.
- Iron and Heatproof Mat

Fabric Requirements:

- 1 1/2 yards each of 2 fabrics (or scrappy equivalent in 4 1/2" Strips at least 12" long)
- 3 yards background
