Description:	We will spend two days piecing together a beautiful log cabin quilt. Students will learn put the blocks together to form a magnificent star design. This class will be great for beginning students and the confident quilter. In class we will discuss the proper way to use a rotary cutter, several ways to obtain the perfect 1/4" seam, proper pressing and the variety of the log cabin block.

Class Requirements:

- Pattern cost to teacher \$7, paid in class.

Class Supplies:

- Sewing Machine in working condition, Foot Pedal, Electrical cord, Sewing Machine manual
- 1/4" machine foot or general sewing foot
- 50 weight neutral thread or thread to match fabric
- 90/14 Sewing Machine needle, Universal or sharp
- several bobbins with 50 weight or bobbin weight neutral thread
- scissors
- pins
- Pen and note pad for taking notes
- 21 Zip lock storage bags
- Rotary cutter please bring an extra blade in case yours goes dull
- Rotary mat
- Rotary cutting ruler – I use a 3" x 12"
- Seam ripper – not that you will need it

Fabric Requirements:

- Black fabric – 5 yards
- White fabric – 4 yards
- Light grey fabric – 2 yards

You are welcome to change the colors, but to achieve the layout, you will need three (3) colors: a dark, a light and a medium.

- We will spend the first couple hours of our first day cutting our fabric so do not put up your machine when you arrive in class.
