| Description: | Lucy is a fun quilt by GE Designs. It is made using 10" squares, <br> therefore it is perfect for using your favorite layer cake. The <br> construction looks difficult, but as with all GE patterns, it is <br> surprisingly easy to piece. The pattern is versatile in that it <br> offers 4 different layouts, all of which look completely different <br> from each other. I had a lot of fun putting this quilt together, <br> and l'm sure you will too! |

Class Requirements:

- Lucy Pattern by GE Designs (Retail $\$ 10.00$ )
- *** The pattern suggests using the Stripology Squared Ruler. This ruler is a bit expensive and is not required for this class. The pattern also gives instructions for using "regular" rulers, and I will be teaching the class using both methods***


## Class Supplies:

- Sewing Machine in good working order.
- Please bring whatever foot allows you to sew an accurate $1 / 4$ " seam.
- Don't forget the power cord and foot pedal. It can also be helpful to bring along the User Manual
- Rotary cutter, mat, and large ruler.
- 8" (or larger) square ruler
- Thread - a color that will blend well with your fabrics. I like to use light gray.
- Basic Sewing Supplies (ie. Scissors, pins, seam ripper)

Fabric Requirements:
It is my suggestion that for the class you make the Lap-sized quilt. If you desire to make a larger or smaller version, please see the pattern for fabric requirements.

- 40 - 10" Colored squares. A layer cake would work wonderfully as they usually have 40 squares, and the fabrics coordinate with one another.
- 3 yards of background fabric.
- Binding and Backing fabric are not required for class, but you may want to purchase it ahead of time. Please see the pattern for requirements.

Pre-class cutting instructions:

- Background fabric - cut into 40 - 10" squares.
