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Class Requirements:

- Sew Kind of Wonderful Starry Night Pattern (Retail \$26.)
- Sew Kind of Wonderful Starry Night Cow Bonus Pattern (optional) (Retail \$12.)
The cow is the same size as the camel in the Starry Night pattern. You can exchange them if you'd like or make a separate one.
- Sew Kind of Wonderful Wonder Curvit Ruler (Retail \$30.)
- Sew Kind of Wonderful Sew Square 4" ruler (optional) (Retail \$16.)

Class Supplies:

- Sewing machine, power cord, instruction manual and foot pedal
- Thread
- Seam ripper (just in case)
- scissors/snips
- Cutting mat
- ruler
- 45mm rotary cutter
- Iron and ironing pad (wool mats must be used with another sewing pad)

Fabric Requirements:

- 1/2 yd—faces
- 3 fat eighths for hair and beard
- 23 assorted fat eighths for clothes, blanket, crook, wings
- 1 fat eighth for star
- 1 fat eighth for manger
- 1 fat eighth for stable
- 1 fat quarter for donkey body
- 2 fat eighths for donkey accents
- 3 fat quarters assorted greens for palm fronds
- 1 fat quarter for tree trunks
- 1 fat quarter for sheep body
- 1 fat eighth for sheep face/accent
- 5 fat eighths assorted for buildings
- 4 10x10 squares for building accents
- 1 fat eighth for building #3 accent
- 1/2 yd for camel fabric
- 2 fat eighths camel accents
- 3 fat quarters for camel blanket
- 1/2 yd main cow fabric (optional for cow)
- 1/4 yd cow head/accent (optional for cow)
- 1 fat eighth cow horn (optional for cow)
- 1 fat eighth cow muzzle/ear (optional for cow)
- 4 1/2 yds background (if cutting all at once) **cutting directions below
OR 5 1/2 yds background (if cutting each block separately)
- 5 yds backing
- 2/3 yd binding

I will have fat quarters available for sale from Somewhere Sewing (Millersburg, Ohio) if you change your mind from what you bring along.

Pre-class Cutting Instructions for the Background Fabric:

Background fabric cutting for the entire quilt top (listed by size and quantity). Be sure to separate and label each group with the size. We will be taking fabrics from various groups for each block. Labeling will make that easier:

9 1/4" x 9 1/4" -1	3 1/2" x 14 1/2" -1
7 1/2" x 14 1/2" -2	3 1/2" x 5" -4
7 1/2" x 11" - 4	3" x 5" -1
7 1/2" x 9 1/4" -1	3" x 3" -3
5 3/4" x 5 3/4" - 42 (then cut in half diagonally)	2 3/4" x 4 1/2" -2
5" x 7 1/2" - 1	2 1/4" x 12" -1
5" x 5" - 4	2 1/4" x 11" -1
4 1/4" x 4 1/4" -16	2 1/4" x 7 1/2" -4
4" x 44 1/4" -1	2 1/4" x 5 3/4" -2
4" x 23 1/4" -1	2 1/4" x 4" - 12
4 x 19 3/4" -1	2 1/4" x 2 1/4" -5
4" x 7 1/2" -14	2" x 2" -1
4" x 5 3/4" -11	1 1/2" x 5 3/4" -2
4" x 4" -11	1 1/4" x 14 1/2" -1

If making the cow, also cut:

4" x 14 1/2" --1	4" x 7 1/2" -1
4" x 5 3/4" --1	5 3/4" x 21 1/2" --1
7 1/2" x 9 1/4" --1	2 1/4" x 19 3/4" - 1
5 3/4" x 5 3/4" --2 (then cut in half diagonally)	2 1/4" x 4" --1
3 1/2" x 5" --8	

This pre-cutting does not include cutting for the various sized sashings throughout the quilt top.
