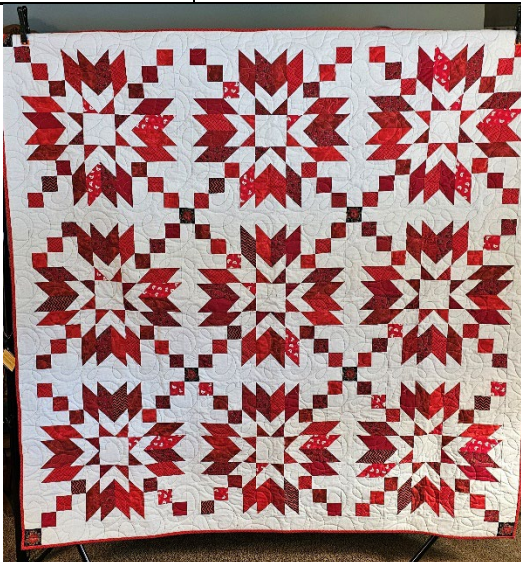


Class 205 Upbeat Supply List

Difficulty Level:	Level 2 - Students should be aware of and have worked on projects using a sewing machine, iron, and rotary tools and have an understanding of proper thread tension, stitch size, and seam allowance consistency.

Make this cheerful, modern design featuring rhythmic star blocks using jelly rolls and one or two fabrics for sashing, background, and borders. Or you could cut strips from your stash instead of jelly rolls. The quilt can be made in several sizes. Twin and Queen sizes require 2 jellyrolls. The pattern is available on Etsy for \$10.80 plus shipping and tax. There are other sites that have this pattern as well. No special rulers required.

Class Requirements:

The pattern name is "Upbeat", designed by Jocelyn Ueng at www.it'sSewEmma.com. It can also be found on several other websites for \$11 or less.

Class Supplies:

- Machine in good working order, foot pedal, cord and manual
- Thread
- Bobbins
- Scissors
- Seam ripper
- Small iron and ironing service (wool mats are not permitted on Cedar Lakes tables)
- 8 ½" square ruler or larger
- 6 ½" x 12" or longer ruler
- Tape measure
- If you have a 20 ½" square ruler, it would be helpful to square up blocks, but not required

Fabric Requirements:

For a throw size (68 ½" x 68 ½") you will need:

- 4 7/8 yards of background fabric
- One jelly roll
- 7/8 yard accent fabric for cornerstones and binding

The pattern has several other size options that may require more than one jelly roll and more background and accent fabrics.

This quilt can be made with scrappy strips from your stash as long as there is a contrast with your background fabric.

Pre-class Cutting Instructions:

Feel free to precut your fabric according to the pattern.
