Description:	Metro Medallion is a fun quilt and a great way of using scraps or feature your favorite fabrics. The method for sewing curves you will learn using the Quick Curve Ruler is not to be feared. The Sew Kind of Wonderful method of seeing curves cut with their Quick Curve Ruler does not use pins or glue. You will end up with nicely sewn curves without pleats and puckers! This pattern can be easily resized.

Class Requirements:

- Metro Medallion Pattern by Sew Kind of Wonderful (retail \$12.00)
- Quick Curve Ruler®(QCR) (Retail \$23-\$26)

Class Supplies:

- Sewing Machine with ¼" foot, foot pedal, power cord, instruction manual.
- Neutral thread
- Marking pen
- Seam ripper.
- There will be a couple of irons and ironing boards in the classroom, but if you prefer your own you may bring one. If you bring a wool pressing mat, you must also have something heat resistant to put under it.
- Pins (not for the curves).
- Cutting Mat
- 45mm rotary cutter with a new blade (I have trouble using the Martelli® cutters with this ruler and prefer a regular Olfa® or Fisker®)

Fabric Requirements:

- (16) 6" x 20" assorted print fabrics (1 per medallion)
OR
(6) fat quarter prints (3 medallions/fat quarter)
- 2 yards curves fabric (gray)
- 1-1/2 yards background fabric (white)
(Optional: (16) 5" x 3 1/2" assorted print fabrics for diamond insets)
- 4 yards backing
- 2/3 yard binding

There are NO pre-class cutting instructions.
