Class Supplies:

- Well running sewing machine (straight stitch only is fine) with foot pedal and cord
- 1/4" presser foot
- 1 1/2" finished half-square triangle paper, or Thangles to make a total of 90 HST units
- fabric requirements from pattern
- Rotary cutter, mat, rulers(6x24 or larger)
- seam ripper
- neutral thread.

Please try to have the basic strips cut for class. I can help during class if you have issues. No need to cut anything for HST units as it will depend on what triangle paper you have, or if you don't have triangle paper. Just cut strips. We can also do setting triangles during class.
