Ripples is a variation on the Storm at Sea quilt. The appearance of three dimensions is created by varying the block size from the middle to the sides. It requires template cutting and piecing as well as traditional piecing. This project is 75" x 75".

- 12 ½" rotary cutting ruler or larger, retail \$18.
- Templates will be available in class from instructor for \$5.

### Class Supplies:

- Sewing machine, with ¼" foot, power cord and foot pedal
- Extra machine needles, oil, and machine manual
- Cutting mat
- A square (12 ½" or so) rotary cutting ruler and any other favorite ruler(s)
- Rotary cutter (45mm or 60mm is fine), extra blades
- Small ruler, 1" x 6" or so is fine
- Seam ripper (sigh...)
- Thread, neutral or color to match fabric
- Iron and approved pressing mat
- Basic sewing supplies – pins, small scissors, etc.
- Paper scissors
- Marking tool (frixion pen, mechanical pencil, pigma pen)

### Fabric Requirements:

This project uses 7 light prints and 5 dark prints.

Light 1 – 1/3 yard

Light 2 – 1/3 yard

Light 3 – 3/8 yard

Light 4 – ½ yard

Light 5 – 2/3 yard

Light 6 – 5/8 yard

Light 7 – ½ yard

Dark 1 – 1/3 yard

Dark 2 – 2/3 yard

Dark 3 – 1 yard

Dark 4 – 7/8 yard

Dark 5 – 1 ¼ yard

Background – 2 ½ yard

### Pre-class Cutting Instructions:

- Light 1 through 4 and Dark 1 fabrics – cut per pattern
- Remaining fabrics – please only cut (and mark) the WOF strips listed in the pattern. We will make the second cuts in class.

Bring all extra fabrics to camp.
