Class Supplies:

- sewing machine, with power cord and foot pedal
- basic sewing supplies including
  - an open toe foot
  - quarter inch seam foot
  - large (60) and medium (45) rotary cutters
  - cutting mats
  - pressing tools (iron and pad)
  - thread

Fabric Requirements:

- $\frac{5}{8}$  yard medium light
- $2 \frac{1}{8}$  yard medium value print
- $\frac{3}{4}$  yard medium
- 1 yard medium
- $\frac{1}{2}$  yard medium
- 1 yard medium dark
- 4 yards light
- $6 \frac{1}{2}$  yards dark
- $1 \frac{3}{8}$  yard medium
- $2 \frac{7}{8}$  yard light background

Once you are signed up for the class, more instruction will be given to help in selecting fabrics. Please be aware this large (99x99) paper piecing project requires almost 21 yards of fabric to make the top. It can be a great use of your stash as long as you have large pieces to work with.

Pre-class cutting instructions:

- Once you are signed up for the class, you will receive cutting and class prep instructions for each of the four days of camp. This is optional but highly recommended to make the most out of your time at camp. A couple of hours of preparation for each day of camp will allow you to make the best use of your time while at camp.
