Class Requirements:

- Class fee: \$50, payable to the teacher in class, will cover any hand-outs, specialty fabrics, interfacings, brushes, cups, and various paints to be used in class for all projects
- Wear comfortable shoes, and clothes that can get dirty, you might get stains from the paints.

Class Supplies:

- 2 20" x 30" foam cord boards. (Any color, available at JoAnn's, Michaels, Hobby Lobby, Dollar Stores).
- Roll of paper towel.
- Mat, rotary cutter and 6" x 12" ruler.
- Scissors.
- Iron and ironing surface.
- Sewing machine in good working order.
- Basic sewing kit.
- Extension cord.

Fabric Requirements:

5 yd. good quality white cotton fabric. I prefer white Kona cotton, but any good quality cotton fabric is fine. Washed, dried, and pressed. If you use PFD (prepared for dyeing) fabric, you should still wash the fabric before class. Smaller pieces and fat quarters are fine as we will cut the fabric for the different techniques.
