Kolache is a striking modern quilt made of lozenge shaped blocks that resemble kolache cookies. The blocks are arranged in a larger lozenge or shield shape. It is suitable for Fat Quarters or yardage. The pattern makes a 70" x 90" quilt. If you wish to make a different size, please contact me via e-mail.

Class Requirements:

- Pattern: Kolache by Create with Claudia. Pattern is available online at www.createwithclaudia.com. Cost is \$10.00.
- Rotary cutting ruler large enough to square up 6 ½" x 12 ½" blocks

Class Supplies:

- Sewing machine, with ¼" foot, power cord and foot pedal
- Extra machine needles, oil, and machine manual
- Cutting mat
- Your 6 ½" x 12 ½" rectangle rotary cutting ruler and any of your favorite size ruler(s)
- Rotary cutter (45mm or 60mm is fine), extra blades
- Seam ripper (sigh...)
- Thread, neutral or color to match fabric
- Iron and pressing mat
- Basic sewing supplies – pins, small scissors, etc.

Fabric Requirements:

- 15 coordinating Fat Quarters OR ¼ yard of 15 prints
- 4 ¼ yards Background fabric
- 1 yard for Outer Border
- ½ yard for optional Inner Border
- 5 ½ yards for backing (won't be needed during Quilt Camp)
- 5/8 yard for binding (won't be needed during Quilt Camp)
